RECAP

TIPPECANOE C.C. Monticello, IN June 15, 2026

The MSGA's fourth tournament of the 2026 season was played at Tippecanoe CC in Monticello, IN on June 15th.

The tournament had a total of 93 players. Players choose the tee of their choice; 36 played from the Gold tees, 32 played from the Blue, and 25 played from the Green.

The lunch was very good as the burgers and chicken were once again grilled as noted by the smoke outside the clubhouse. The course was in great shape and keeping your golf ball in play was at a premium, especially on the dog leg holes and the beautiful yet treacherous holes along the river and the inlets.

The course played difficult but fair, as twelve players bested Net par of 72 while two other matched Net par. For the 93 players, the average Gross score was 90.0 and the average Net score was 77.6 which is close to the normal range 3 to 5 over par for Net.

In the Individual Medal competition for Gross scores by flight, Ron Dockery in A Flight led with an even par 72 followed by Doug Schnick (C) with 75 and John Oliver (B) with 79.

In the Individual Medal competition for Net by flight, Robert Dragani (A) led with a great Net six under 66 followed by Cory Dennie (A) with Net 68 and Steve Hissong (B) with Net 69. A total of seventeen players shot below par Net. Players are allowed only one award, so those with Gross and Net awards are limited to one award each.

In the Skins competition, Bill Murray, Billy Davis, Roger Danielson, and Dennis Rogala recorded three skins each while JB Overmyer, Doug Schnick, Bruce Ruge, Michael Spartz, Chuck Zimmerman, Roy Andrysiak and Michael Balunda recorded two skins each. There was a total of 42 skins in the six flights.

In the Closest-to-the-Pin contests, Woody Woodiwiss (Blue tees) recorded the closest with a 4' 3" shot on hole #9 playing from 133 yards followed closely by Doug Schnick (Blue tees) at 4' 8" on hole #15 from 156 yards.

Congratulations to award winners and especially to Ron Dockery with his even par round of 72. Congrats to the new 2026 members and particularly those who won awards.
